

**ALBUM IN A YEAR:** March online material

**As Luck Would Have It** by Amanda Probst. **Supplies** Cardstock: Prism Papers; Photo corners: Heidi Swapp; Glaze: Glossy Accents by Ranger; Acrylic paint: Plaid; Computer fonts: Kravitz, downloaded from the internet; CK Jessica, downloaded from ScrapNFonts.com.

Step by step instructions to recreate this layout:

1. Select seven 4x6 photos. Trim each to 4x4 squares. (Note: Feel free to substitute patterned paper for some of these if you don't have seven photos. Or add more if desired...you could easily fill the space on the far right hand side with three more photos instead of journaling.)
2. Print title block and trim to 4x8. I printed on colored cardstock and used acrylic paint to fill in the title letters. I then used Glossy Accents on the star element and set it aside to dry.
3. Print subtitle block and trim to 4x4. Add photo corners. (If you end up with a different number of photos than seven, my plan would be to print or stamp or write your number on a different colored piece of cardstock and then use a circle punch around it. Adhere the circle tag over the top of the "7".)
4. Print journaling on background cardstock. (For this, I set it up in Adobe InDesign, using the text wrap feature to block around the title block.) Adjust font size and spacing to fit your space. I added little dingbats between each journaling bit and printed those in a different color then used Glossy Accents atop them. (Alternately, be brave and simply handwrite your journaling directly onto your background.)
5. Arrange and adhere photos and title/subtitle blocks as shown.
