

## **ALBUM IN A YEAR:** September online material

**Lessons Learned** by Amanda Probst. **Supplies** Cardstock: Prism Papers; Lace cardstock: KI Memories; *Journaling tags*: Heidi Swapp; *Twill ribbon*: Creative Impressions; *Photo corner label*: Imagination Project; *Pen*: Precision Pen, American Crafts; *Computer fonts*: Penmanship Print, Webdings, downloaded from the internet (unknown); CK Tea Party, downloaded from ScrapNFonts.com.

Step by step instructions to recreate this layout:

1. Cut one 12"x12" sheet of lace cardstock so that you end with one 5"x12" piece and one 7"x12" piece. Adhere to background cardstock (green) on outside edges. (I simply taped down the portion that will be covered...the rest is loose and held in place by the page protector.)
2. Cut two pieces of cardstock (red) to 10"x8". Adhere to background pages, centered vertically (2" from top and bottom) and flush to the center of the layout.
3. Select and print five 4x6 photos (three vertical, two horizontal). Position on layout as shown (1" from top and bottom of the layout) and adhere.
4. Print title block and trim to 8"x3". Cut piece of matching cardstock to 6"x1.5" for left page. Position as shown and adhere.
5. Add twill ribbon directly below title block and matching cardstock just cut in step 4.
6. Write your journaling on tags/labels and adhere. I used pre-made labels and hand-wrote my journaling then adhered using foam squares for dimension. Feel free to create your own journaling blocks by printing journaling on the computer.
7. If desired, finish off by adding a pen outline and adhering a photo corner (mine says the name of the month) to the red cardstock.
