

ALBUM IN A YEAR: October online material

TIMEpieces by Amanda Probst. **Supplies** Cardstock: Prism Papers; *Patterned paper*: American Crafts, Luxe; *Chipboard gears*: Cosmo Cricket; *Felt ribbon*: Creative Imaginations; *Brads, metal loop*: Creative Impressions; *Pens*: Precision Pen, American Crafts; *Bik Mark It*; *Computer fonts*: Century Gothic, Microsoft Word; Century Schoolbook, Microsoft Word; Karabine, downloaded from Dafont.com; *Other*: buttons.

Step by step instructions to recreate this layout:

1. Print/trim twelve 2" x 5" photos and arrange in chronological order.
2. On the background cardstock, print journaling in small blocks (2" wide). Journaling should fit within the top 2" of the pages. (An alternative to printing this journaling would be simple handwriting or fun individual tags/journaling blocks above each photo.) Note: for my journaling, I kept it very simple by simply listing the date and a few descriptive words.
3. Adhere photos to background cardstock as shown. (Top edge of photos should be roughly 2" from the top of the cardstock.)
4. Print title block on cardstock and trim to 8.5" x 3". Position in bottom right corner of layout and adhere.
5. Cut three strips of patterned paper to add to the lower portion of the layout. Two of the strips should be 6" long, one should be 8" long. Vary the height of the strips as desired. Adhere as shown.
6. Add brads, metal loop and felt ribbon to patterned paper strips.
7. Add and adhere chipboard gears with button centers around the title block as shown.
8. If desired, add pen borders around entire layout and select photos.
